This curriculum was designed by Melissa Baralt, Aris Clemons, Uju Anya, and Déborah Gómez and was funded by the National Endowment from the Humanities.

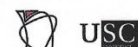

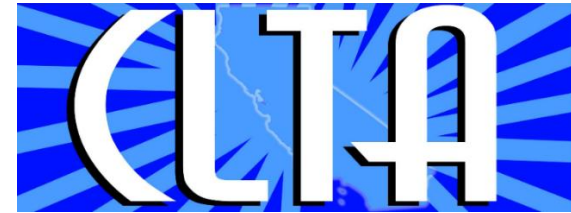
