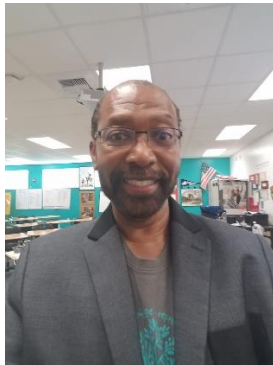

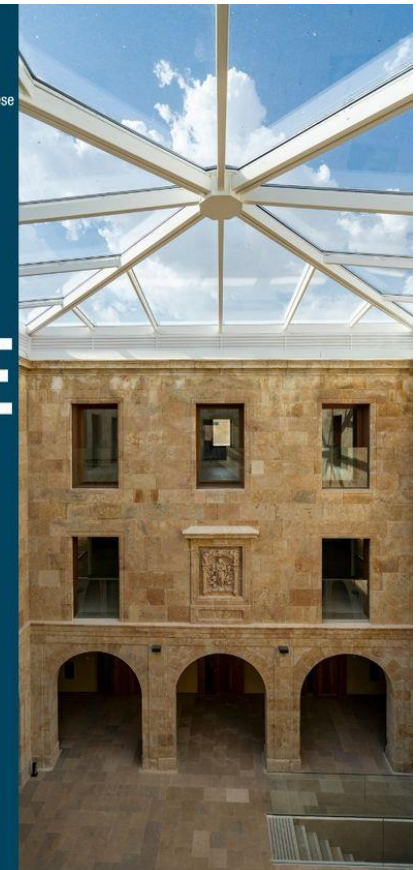

A **free**, fully task-based, and open-access Spanish language curriculum has just been released to the public. The curriculum centers Blackness in Latin America and Black language learners and was designed based off a needs analysis study that was conducted with over 300 Spanish-language learners in the Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU) and Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HIS) setting. This curriculum was designed by Melissa Baralt, Aris Clemons, Uju Anya, and Déborah Gómez and was funded by the National Endowment from the Humanities.

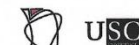

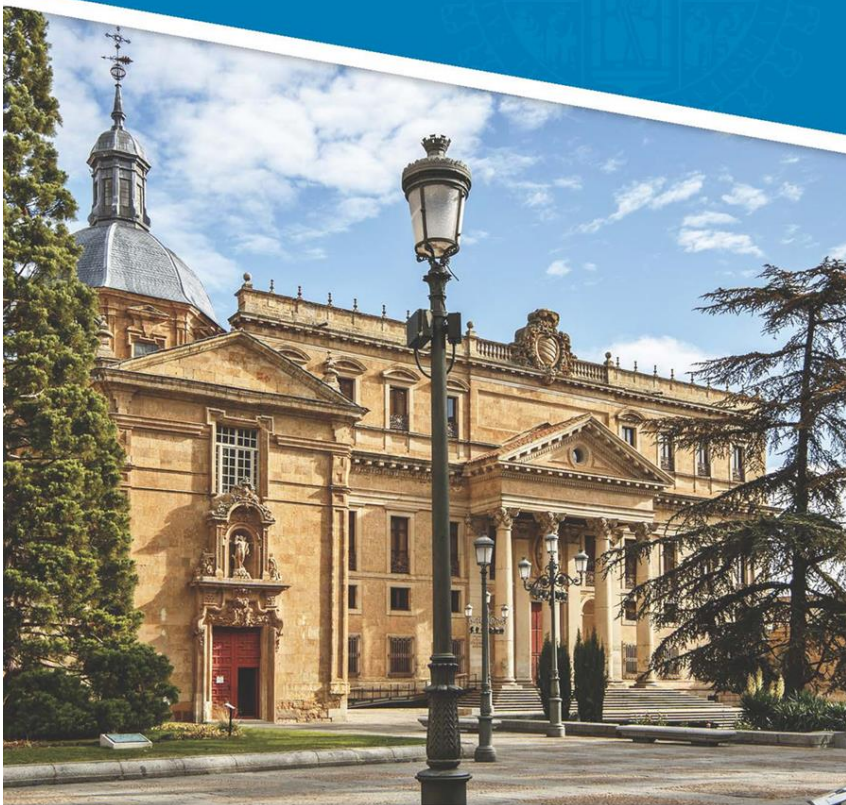

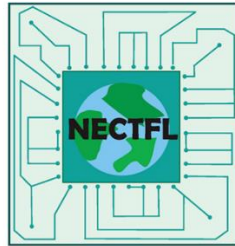
