Sesión de cine y Masterclass posterior impartida por el profesor [D. Fernando Rodríguez Lafuente](#), profesor, crítico literario y cinematográfico y gestor cultural español. Actualmente director del **Máster Universitario en Cultura Contemporánea** de la Fundación Ortega-Marañón. Exdirector general del Instituto Cervantes y exdirector general del libro, archivo y bibliotecas del Ministerio de Cultura del Gobierno de España.

La deriva sangrienta del conflicto y el encarcelamiento de algunos de sus compañeros provoca que Unamuno empiece a cuestionar su postura inicial y a sopesar sus principios.*

Cuando Franco traslada su cuartel a Salamanca y es nombrado Jefe del Estado en la zona nacional, Unamuno acude a su Palacio, decidido a hacerle una petición.

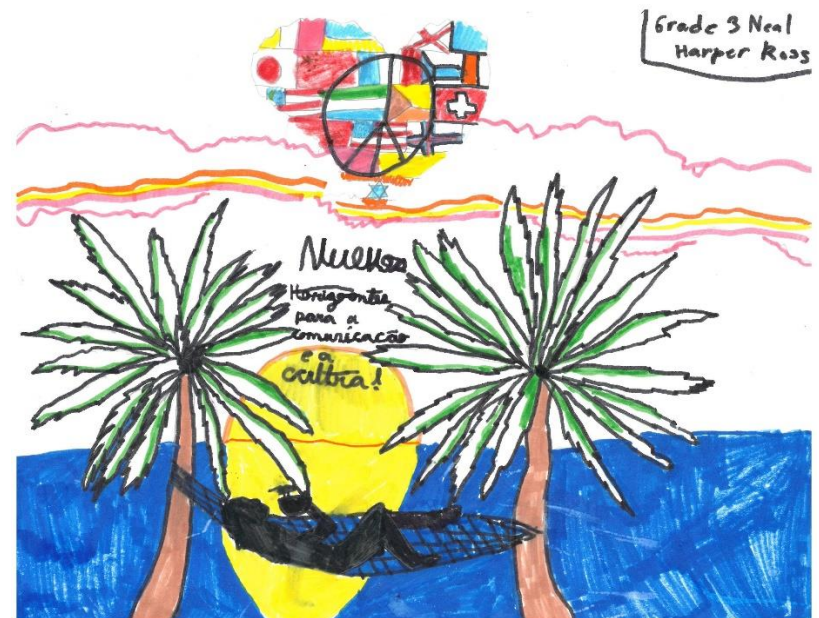

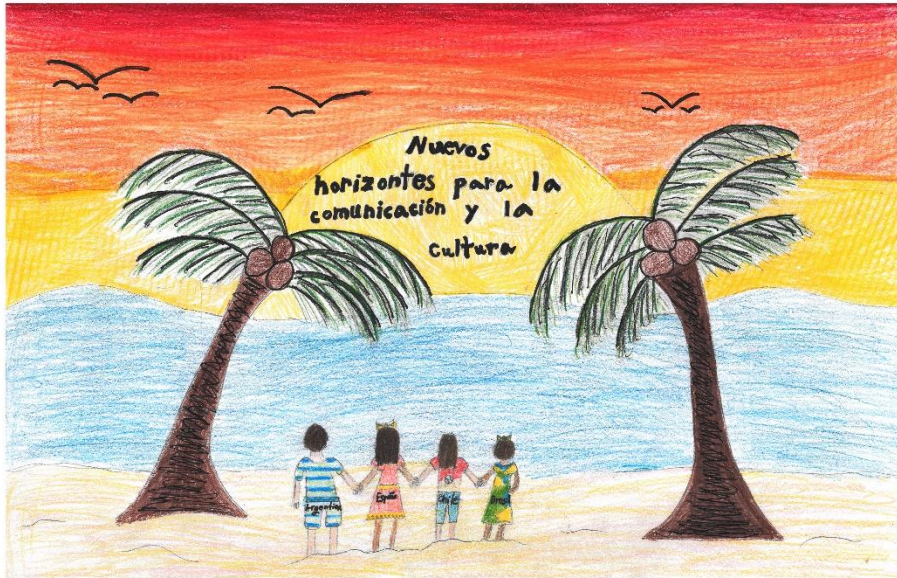

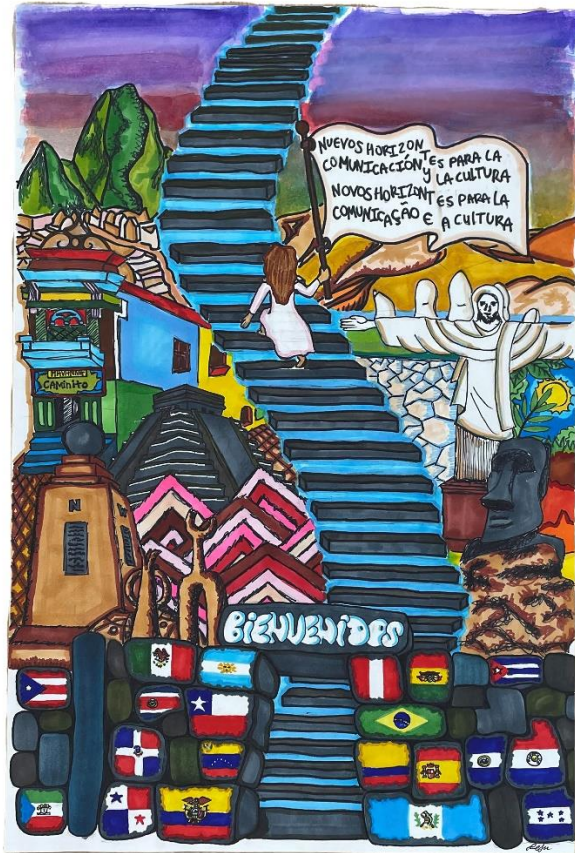

On behalf of the Board of Directors, the AATSP is proud to announce the new Ambassador Membership for high school students that want to join the Sociedad Honoraria Hispánica (SHH). The Ambassador Membership has been a multi-year undertaking developed by the SHH Advisory Board. The new membership type supports the Association's values of inclusion and access. The honor society that currently has over 3,000 chapters in the United States and abroad.

The Ambassador Membership is designed for heritage learners and students who were enrolled in Dual Language Immersion programs prior to high school. The SHH Ambassador Membership or *Membresía Embajadora* is for students who are unable to meet the traditional requirements of course study and/or enrollment in Spanish or Portuguese classes.

SHH Student Membership Types

Regular Membership

Students must:

- have completed at least 3 semesters of Spanish or Portuguese with an honor average
- be currently enrolled in a Spanish or Portuguese class
- be in the 10th grade or higher

Ambassador Membership

NEW

Students must:

- be heritage learner students and/or enrolled in dual-language program prior to high school
- prove proficiency in Spanish or Portuguese without meeting the traditional language course requirement.
- demonstrate a continuing interest in promoting the Spanish or Portuguese languages and their cultures
- are in the 10th grade or higher

Ambassador members receive all benefits of regular membership.

Associate Membership

Students who are inducted as regular members then choose to stop taking language courses become Associate Members with limited benefits. Associate members:

- may not vote, hold office, or be eligible to receive scholarship or travel awards of the SHH
- may receive graduation regalia with active participation in the Chapter through senior year

Honorary Membership

Honorary Membership may be granted to a person in the school or community (administrators, community members, exchange students, etc.) who

- has demonstrated an interest in the promotion and advancement of the purposes of the SHH.
- is involved with or important to the local chapter of the SHH.

SHH OPPORTUNITIES & POLICY REMINDERS

As we are in our busiest season for student recognition, the Sociedad Honoraria Hispánica wants to remind all sponsors of SHH policies.

- All sponsors must be current members of the [AATSP](#).
- In order to be considered active, a chapter must induct new regular members each year, paying each student's \$5 membership dues to the AATSP.
- Ambassador Membership is now available for heritage learners or former Dual Language Immersion students unable to meet traditional membership requirements. [Click here](#) to view guidelines for Ambassador Membership. Ambassador Members are registered separately from regular members and will receive a certificate denoting their Ambassador Membership status.
- Before a sponsor can purchase official SHH merchandise, including graduation regalia and additional certificates, the sponsor must register inductees for the 2022-2023 school year.

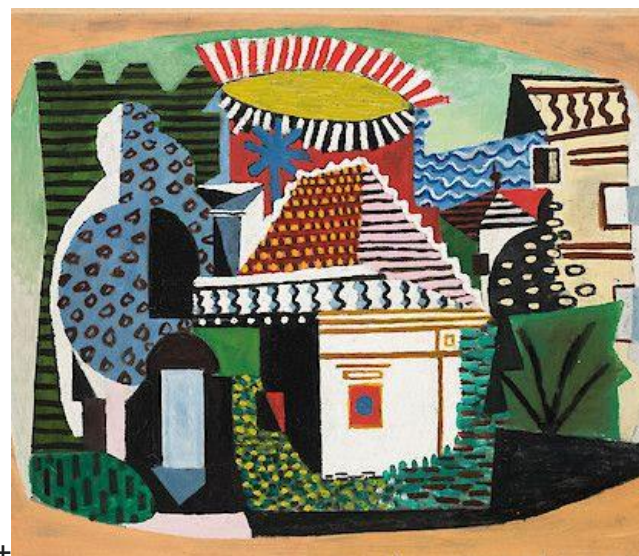

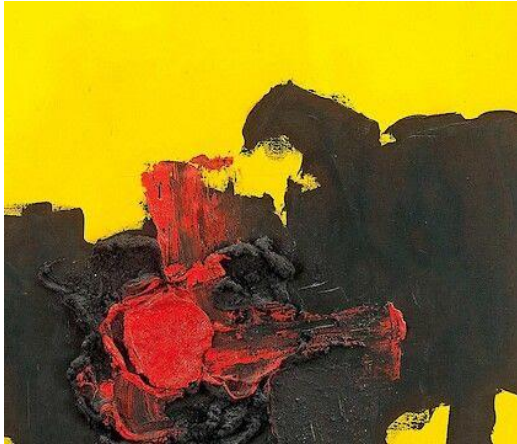
